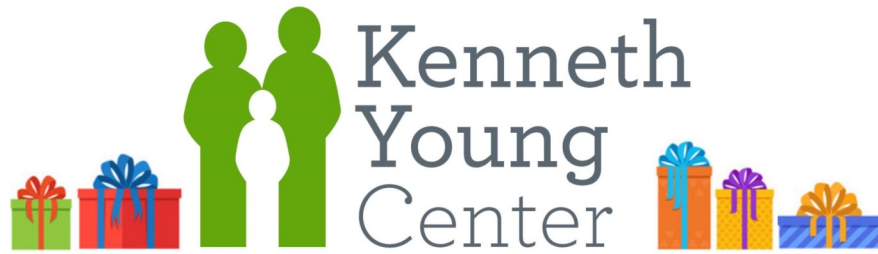

- Individual, family, and group therapy
- Psychiatric evaluation and medication monitoring
- 24-hour Mobile Crisis Response for children and adults at risk of self harm or harm to others
- Mentoring for youth to practice behavior management skills in the community
- Counseling for teens/young adults struggling with substance abuse and mental disorders
- Alcohol and drug prevention services to schools, community groups, and awareness coalitions
- Collaboration with local school districts for resource coordination
- LGBTQ+ Center to support and build community for youth and young adults
